ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 16-01
ADOPTING MODIFIED LOSS MITIGATION PROGRAM PROCEDURES
EFFECTIVE MARCH 15, 2016

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2013 the Loss Mitigation Program Procedures and the Loss Mitigation Program described therein were adopted by Administrative Order #13-05 to facilitate consensual resolutions for individual debtors whose residential real property is at risk of loss to foreclosure; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order #13-05, the Loss Mitigation Program Procedures may be modified by Administrative Order from time to time as deemed necessary by the Judges of the Northern District of New York Bankruptcy Court; and

WHEREAS, the Judges of the Northern District of New York Bankruptcy Court comprised a working group of creditor and debtor attorneys, standing trustees, law clerks and Clerk's office personnel to review and recommend changes to the Loss Mitigation Program Procedures and the related forms.

Now, therefore, it is hereby


ORDERED, that the revised "Loss Mitigation Program Procedures" annexed to this Administrative Order and the Loss Mitigation Program described therein are adopted, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105(a); and it is further

ORDERED, that the revised Loss Mitigation Program Procedures shall take effect March 15, 2016, and apply to any pending and future request for Loss Mitigation; and it is further

ORDERED, that the revised Loss Mitigation Program Procedures and related forms shall be available on the court's website; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Administrative Order augments Administrative Order #13-05, which shall remain in full force and effect.
