
ORDER

WHEREAS Lois R. Lupica, Professor of Law at the University of Maine School of Law has requested an exemption from Electronic Public Access fees for her academic research; and

WHEREAS this Court finds that an exemption is necessary to avoid unnecessary burdens and to promote public access to information;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, on 4/2/10, that the request is granted. A waiver of PACER fees for accessing documents of record in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of New York shall be effected for the benefit of Professor Lois R. Lupica. The exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court during this one-year period. In compliance with the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States, Lois R. Lupica shall not sell the data obtained by use of this exemption.

The Clerk shall give appropriate Notice of this Order.
