This matter is before the Court upon the letter request dated April 2, 2014 by Law Alumni Association Professor of Law Margaret Howard (“ Professor Howard”) for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

THEREFORE the Court finds that Professor Howard, as an individual researcher associated with Washington and Lee University School of Law in Lexington, Virginia, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Professor Howard has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Professor Howard shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of research regarding individual chapter 11 cases and a comparison with chapter 13 cases and corporate chapter 11 cases; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED Professor Howard shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the following limitations apply: (1) this fee exemption applies only to Professor Howard and is valid only for the purpose stated above; (2) this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system; (3) Professor Howard shall not sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption; (4) Professor Howard is and shall be prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption; (5) this exemption is valid until March 31, 2015; (6) if necessary, Professor Howard may request an extension of the fee exemption granted in this Order, based upon an additional showing of need conforming to Judicial Conference Policy; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED this exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time and a copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
