

**ORDER WAIVING PACER FEES FOR BRIGHAM YOUNG UNIVERSITY
FOR A 3 MONTH PERIOD FOR PURPOSES OF RESEARCH**

This Court has reviewed the request of Dr. Lars Lefgren and Dr. Frank McIntyre to have PACER fees waived from September 1, 2005 to December 1, 2005. Dr. Lefgren and Dr. McIntyre are professors of economics at Brigham Young University and wish to examine bankruptcy data for a study on how the incidence of bankruptcy varies across income distributions and the extent to which bankruptcy serves as insurance for medical, legal and employment shocks. This Court finds that the request meets the two standards established by Congress for granting PACER fee exemptions; the avoidance of unreasonable burdens and the promotion of public access to information. This limited exemption of PACER fees applies only to research for the study being conducted by Dr. Lefgren and Dr. McIntyre and is not intended for any purposes unrelated to the study. After consultation with the Clerk of the Court, and finding it to be a reasonable request,

It is ORDERED THAT the PACER fees be waived from September 1, 2005 to December 1, 2005 and that a separate PACER account, valid only from September 1, 2005 to December 1, 2005, be established.
