**ORDER WAIVING PACER FEES FOR MASSACHUSETTS INSTITUTE OF  
TECHNOLOGY  
FOR A TWO MONTH PERIOD FOR PURPOSES OF RESEARCH**

This Court has reviewed the request of Antoinette Schoar, Professor of Finance, Sloan School of Management, MIT to have PACER fees waived from July 1, 2006 to September 1, 2006. Professor Schoar and her MIT economist team wish to examine bankruptcy data for a study on long term effects of specific bankruptcy rulings on the performance of small and medium size firms post Chapter 11 reorganization. This Court finds that the request meets the two standards established by Congress for granting PACER fee exemptions; the avoidance of unreasonable burdens and the promotion of public access to information. This limited exemption of PACER fees applies only to research for the study being conducted by Professor Antoinette Schoar and is not intended for any purposes unrelated to the study. After consultation with the Clerk of Court, and finding it to be reasonable request,

It is ORDERED THAT the PACER fees be waived from July 1, 2006 to September 1, 2006 and that a separate PACER account, valid only from July 1, 2006 to September 1, 2006, be established.
