

**ORDER WAIVING PACER FEES FOR HARVARD LAW SCHOOL
FOR PURPOSES OF ACADEMIC RESEARCH**

This Court has reviewed the request of Professor Elizabeth Warren to have PACER fees waived. Professor Warren is a professor of law at Harvard Law School and wishes to examine bankruptcy data for several academic research projects. This Court finds that the request meets the two standards established by Congress for granting PACER fee exemptions; the avoidance of unreasonable burdens and the promotion of public access to information. This limited exemption of PACER fees applies only to research being conducted by Professor Warren and is not intended for any purposes unrelated to academic research. After consultation with the Clerk of the Court, and finding it to be a reasonable request,

It is ORDERED THAT the PACER fees be waived from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010 and that a PACER account be established, valid through December 31, 2010.
