REPEAL OF ORDER ADOPTING
INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULES

Whereas, on April 20, 2005 the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the Act) was enacted into law; and

Whereas, the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Judicial Conference of the United States approved Interim Rules for adoption to provide uniform procedures for implementing the Act; and

Whereas, on August 26, 2005 the judges of this Court adopted the Interim Rules in their entirety; and

Whereas, new rules and amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure implementing the substantive and procedural changes to the Bankruptcy Code made by the Act take effect on December 1, 2008 and supercede the Interim Rules (with the exception of Interim Rule 5012);

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this Court's August 26, 2005 order adopting the Interim Rules is repealed, except for Interim Rule 5012 which shall be retained until it is replaced by a permanent national rule.
