**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 17-07**


Based upon an amendment to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002(c), Administrative Order 16-09, dated December 15, 2016, is amended to provide that the following rules shall apply in cases converted from chapter 11 to chapter 7 in which there are assets and a claims bar date is to be noticed:

1. If the original bar date set in the chapter 11 case for governmental units to file claims has expired, then the Clerk shall set a 70-day claims bar date from the date of the order of conversion for both governmental units and general creditors to file claims;
2. If the original bar date set in the chapter 11 case for governmental units to file claims has not expired and there are 70 days or more for the period to run from the order of conversion, then the Clerk shall utilize the original governmental units' bar date as the claims bar date for governmental units and the Clerk shall set a 70-day claims bar date from the date of the order of conversion for general creditors to file claims;
3. If the original bar date set in the chapter 11 case for governmental units to file claims has not expired and there are less than 70 days for the period to run, then the Clerk shall set a 70-day claims bar date from the date of the order of conversion for both governmental units and general creditors to file claims.

This Order shall take effect on December 1, 2017.
