
**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 19-07
ADOPTING REVISED LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES
EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2019**

Following publication notice and comment period, the bankruptcy judges have approved revisions to certain designated Local Bankruptcy Rules for the Northern District of New York to reflect this court's current practice and procedure and to conform to amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, effective December 1, 2019.¹ As revised, Local Bankruptcy Rules 1002-1, 2019-1, 4001-1, 5005-1, 7003-1, 7055-1, 9013-1, and 9037-1 are set forth on the attached Exhibit A ("Revised Local Bankruptcy Rules").

Pursuant to the District Court's March 7, 2014 General Order #21, signed by then presiding Chief District Court Judge Gary L. Sharpe, the Revised Local Bankruptcy Rules have been forwarded to the Board of Judges for the Northern District of New York.

It is hereby ORDERED that the Revised Local Bankruptcy Rules are adopted, effective December 1, 2019, and all prior versions of the designated Rules are superseded and rescinded.
