 - iv. Application requesting relief from stay due to default in direct payments to secured creditor pursuant to the Chapter 13 Confirmation Order
 - v. Notice of Default and proof of service.
 - vi. Proof of service of the Notice of Default.
- You will be prompted to answer yes or no at the following screen: Choose "Yes". This will prevent the system from charging you the filing fee.
