Rule 3002.1 - Notice of Mortgage Payment Change New Events in CM/ECF and New Forms

Effective December 1, 2011, three new events became available and are required to be filed by mortgage creditors as supplements to the claim. These new events are found in the "Claims Action" category of CM/ECF but will not appear on the public docket report. Instead the events will appear on the claims register history.

The events to be filed by a mortgage creditor are:

- Notice of Mortgage Payment Change
- Notice of Postpetition Mortgage fees, Expenses and Charges
- Response to Notice of Final Cure Payment Rule 3002.1

There are instances where a Notice of Mortgage Payment Change is filed without an actual proof of claim to relate to. This event is found in the "*Creditor*" category. This event will appear on the public docket report and will not appear on the claims register history. The event is:

Notice of Mortgage Payment Change with No Proof of Claim
