Information for Participating in a Hearing by Telephone

through AT&T Conference Call Feature

In order to protect the public health and prevent the spread of the COVID-19, the court has implemented the following procedures for telephonic hearings in the Albany division. Unless

otherwise directed by the court, all hearings will be held telephonically using this AT&T system

at no cost to the parties or the public.

Pursuant to NDNY LR 5.8, recording of any court proceeding, regardless of the medium, is

prohibited without prior notification and approval of the presiding judicial officer. Likewise, LBR

5007-1 prohibits recording or broadcasting of judicial proceedings.

It is our intent to continue to make digital audio recordings of court hearings in the Albany division

available on the court's docket through PACER. The files are generally available 24 to 48 hours

after the conclusion of a hearing.

<u>Dial-In Procedures for AT&T Conference Call Feature</u> in the Albany Division

• Please dial the AT&T (toll-free) teleconferencing number as provided below five (5)

minutes before the calendar is scheduled to begin. Calling in any earlier may throw others

off the line and terminate the conference call before it begins.

• Enter the access code associated with the call-in number. You will hear a message that the

"host has not joined the call." When the court is ready to proceed, the courtroom deputy

will bring all participants into the call.

• Do not speak until your matter is called. Place the phone on mute, but do not place the call

on hold.

• Once your case is called, you may speak. Each time you speak, identify yourself for the

record.

• If you are dropped from the call or have trouble joining the call, hang up and try dialing

back in. If you are unsuccessful, email the courtroom deputy at:
