

Effective December 1, 2018, two new CM/ECF events will be available. One event relates to the filing of a motion to determine validity of payment change under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3002.1(b)(2). The other relates to the filing of a direct appeal under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 8006. Please call the CM/ECF Help Desk with any questions regarding the filing of documents.

**New Events:**

***Bankruptcy > Motions/Applications > Motion to Determine Validity of Payment Change***

*This event asks if the payment change is related to a home equity line of credit. The motion is scheduled for a hearing and not subject to the default motion practice.*

***Bankruptcy > Appeal > Supplemental Statement RE: Certification of Direct Appeal***

*This event allows parties to file their supplemental statement when the court certifies direct review on the court's own motion.*

**Form Change:**

The Chapter 13 Order of Discharge form is changed as follows:  
Bullet point on page 2, describing certain debts not discharged in chapter 13, was changed from “debts for most fines, penalties, forfeitures, or criminal restitution obligations” to “debts for restitution, or a criminal fine, included in a sentence on debtor’s criminal conviction.” The revised language is derived from 11 U.S.C. § 1328(a)(3).
